(ساده فقرات) Affirmative Sentences

Examples:

Jumbled	In, the, were, they, playing, cricket, ground	Arranged	They were playing cricket in the ground.
Jumbled	Regularly, offer, they, prayer, their	Arranged	They offer their prayer regularly.
Jumbled	Will, be, them, of, all, you, for, waiting	Arranged	All of them will be waiting for you.
Jumbled	Twice, day, He, a, cleans, teeth, his	Arranged	He cleans his teeth twice a day.

(منفی فقرات) Negative Sentences

منفی (Negative) فقرات کورتیب دیتے وقت ایک بات ذہن میں رکھنی جا ہیے کہ (Two clauses) والے فقرات کے علاوہ ہر فقر سے میں Not کا استعال کرنا ضروری ہوتا ہے جو کر ہے ترتیب (Jumbled) فقرات میں پہلے سے موجود ہوتا ہے منفی (Negative) فقرات کی ترتیب مندرجہ ذیل اصول اور ترتیب کے تحت عمل میں ا

Examples:

Jumbled	Quiet, can, he, not, keep	Arranged	He cannot keep quiet.
Jumbled	Not, care, anybody, for, he, does	Arranged	He does not care for anybody.
Jumbled	His, has, work, now, till, completed, now, not, he	Arranged	He has not completed his work till now.
Jumbled	Will, he, waiting, you, for, not, be	Arranged	He will not be waiting for you.
Jumbled	Been, since, year, last, winning, not, medal, they, have, the	Arranged	They have not been winning the medal since last year.

Interrogative Sentences: (حواله فقرات)

برتر تیب سوالیہ فقرات کوتر تیب وینا دوسر نے فقرات کی نسبت زیادہ مختاط کام ہے کیونکہ فقر سے میں صرف امدادی فعل (Helping Verb) کا آجانا ہی کافی نہیں ہوتا ۔اس کے لئے ہم بے تر تیب فقر ہے کی (رموزاوقاف) Punctuation پرغور کریں تو آخر میں (Question Mark) سوالیہ نشان فقر سے کے سوالیہ ہونے کو ناہر کر دیتا ہے۔
